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Metformin

SGLT-2 Inhibitors

GLP-1 Receptor Agonists

Options like semaglutide and liraglutide mimic the action of incretin hormones, stimulating insulin release and decreasing glucagon secretion.





Insulin Therapies

Various insulin formulations, including long-acting and rapid-acting options, cater to individualized needs for blood sugar control.



DPP-4 Inhibitors

Sitagliptin and saxagliptin enhance insulin secretion and suppress glucagon release, contributing to blood sugar regulation.
